I want to draw your attention to our two break times, children should be provided with two snacks rather than a lunch to have in the two break times. Please send your children with a snack they can eat and still have time to enjoy a break, the first snack should be a small and easy to eat item, the second snack can be a little more substantial but it is not a full lunch. Please ensure that your child has had a good breakfast before they arrive in school.

Safeguarding Culture at Hornbill School

The safety and security of your children is our main concern at Hornbill School.

Information

We hold information of allergies and medical conditions where it applies.

We hold risk assessments in school for in school activities and out of school visits.

End of day routine

The school day will always end at school. If children are being taught away from the school site, they will always be returned to school. Some children return home on the school bus, buses have an escort.

Site safety

School site is protected with locked gates.

All visitors to school must sign in at the school reception and sign out at the end of the visit.

Accidents in school are always reported via a completed form and are added to the accident database.

Safeguarding

Staff and volunteers will hold a Level 2 Safeguarding Qualification.

Some school staff have a Level 3 Safeguarding Qualification.

Mr Walters, Assistant Head Teacher, is the Designated Safeguarding Lead. The Deputy is Mrs Brown, Deputy Head Teacher.

The school holds concern records for children and will report statutory social work concerns to the Social Worker.

Some staff hold a full L3 Paediatric First Aid Certificate.

Some staff hold a L2 First Aid at Work Certificate.

Every member of staff and all volunteers are subject to an enhanced DBS check. All staff have been checked against the barred list, in addition, teachers are checked against the prohibition from teaching list.
